Class Descriptions

Equitation Divisions

Beginner Walk-Trot

Rider must be in their 1st or 2nd of showing,

Have never shown above the beginner level

Cannot have placed 1st in the year end awards for this division, crossrail division, or have won the crossrail medal

Riders will be asked to walk and trot as a group

Class #3 riders will be asked to individually canter at least halfway around the arena

May also enter the novice and crossrail equitation divisions or crossrail medal

Crossrail Equitation & Crossrail Medal

Open to any rider in their first three years of showing over fences 18" in height

Riders cannot have won 1st place in the year end awards for crossrail divisions or medal final more than one time.

Riders will not be penalized for trotting on course or simple changes

Testing will be permitted in the flat phase. Riders should be prepared to ride tests number 1,3,5,8, and perform an emergency dismount.

Short/Long Stirrup Equitation 2' & SS/LS Medal

Open to riders in their first 3 years of showing fences 2' in height

Riders cannot have won 1st place in the year end awards for S/L stirrup division and medal, more than one time

Riders cannot be penalized for simple changes; however, they can be penalized for trotting on course

Testing will be permitted during the flat phase. Riders should be prepared to ride tests number 1,3-6,8,11,14 and perform an emergency dismount.

Advanced Equitation & Medal 2'6" or 3'

Riders will be penalized for trotting on course and simple changes unless instructed to do so.

Riders must declare fence height on entry form before competition begins.

Once riders make the decision to move up in fence height they may not return to a lower fence height.

Testing will be permitted during the flat phase. Riders should be prepared to ride tests number 1-19.

Hunter Divisions

Baby Green Hunter 18"

- Horse or rider must be in his/her 1st or 2nd year of showing over 18" fences
- All fences will be simple verticles or crossrails
- Fences will have no width, no walls, roll tops, or in-and-outs
- There will be at least one change of direction
- There will be no penalty for trotting on course or simple changes of lead

Green Hunter 2'

- Horse must be in his 1st or 2nd year of showing over fences greater than 18"
- There will be no penalty for trotting on course or simple changes of lead
- In-and-outs are not permitted
- There will be at least one change of direction
- Width of oxers may not exceed 2'6"

Open Hunter 2'6" or 3'

- Open to all horses and ponies
- Riders must declare fence height on entry form prior to competition
- Once a horse has competed at a set fence height, they may not return to a lower fence height
- Oxers may not exceed 3' or 3'6" respectively in width
- In and outs will be permitted

Jumper Divisions

Time First – Jump Off

- Riders jump around the designated course and stop, remain in the arena
- If they have no jumping faults or time faults, when given the signal from the judge they ride the jump off course.
- Time + faults in the jump off determines the final placings

Power and Speed

- Riders jump around the designated course
- If the rider has no jump or time faults, upon completing the initial course, without stopping, the rider immediately proceeds to jump around the jump off course.
- Time + faults in the jump off determines the final placings

Fault and Out

- A specific time will be posted on the course
- Riders jump the course receiving 2pts for each fence cleared and 1 pt for any fence where a rail is pulled
- Rider must stop when either they pull a rail or the time runs out
- If the rider completes the course while time is still remaining, rider is to begin the course over again until they either pull a rail or time runs out.

Hunter Divisions

Novice Horse/Rider

- Open to any rider or horse in their 1st year of showing over fences 18" in height
- Riders cannot have won 1st place in the year end awards for this division
- Riders will not be penalized for trotting on course or simple changes
- All jumps will be simple crossrails
- Under saddle will be asked to canter in very small groups

Baby Green Hunter 18"

- Horse or rider must be in their first 3 years of showing over fences

All fences will be simple verticals or crossrails
There will be at least one change of direction
There will be no penalty for trotting on course or simple changes of lead

Green or Schooling Hunter 2'

In and outs are not permitted
There will be no penalty for simple changes of lead
There will be at least one change of direction
Width of oxers may not exceed 2'6"

Open Hunter 2'6" or 3'

Open to all horses and ponies
Riders must declare fence height on entry form prior to competition
Once a horse has competed at a set fence height they may not return to a lower fence height
Oxers may not exceed 3' or 3'6" respectively in width
In and outs will be permitted

ARENAS

Beginner/Crossrail Ring is 120' x 240' fenced arena with M10 all weather footing.

All classes 2' and over will be held (weather permitting) in a grassy 200' x 300' fenced in field. Schooling is permitted prior to the start of the first 2' class.
